A WORD FROM GOD

(Exodus 20:1-17)

1. Reawaken an awareness of the Ten Commandments.

Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. **Teach them to your children**, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 11:18-19

2. Reveals the nature and character of God.

Gen. 1:1-3
And God said...
His physical power.

Ex. 20:1
And God spoke...
His spiritual power.

3. Reaffirm that these Commandments are absolutes from God.

But the LORD is the true God. Jeremiah 10:10

All your words are true; all your righteous laws are eternal. Psalm 119:160

4. Recognize that God's design is to call us to repentance and to point us to Jesus.

*Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, **through the law** we become **conscious** of sin.*

*But now a righteousness from God, **apart** from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption **that came by Christ Jesus**.*
