## I. Seeks and searches for the lost.

Christianity is God seeking man.

*It was in the cool of the morning that God asked,  
"Where are you?" Genesis 3:9*

## II. Attracts the lost.

Cf. Matthew 9:10-12

**Why are sinners so comfortable with Jesus  
yet so uncomfortable with most Christians?**

## III. Values the lost.

A. Created in His image. Gen. 1:27

B. Placed within you an eternity. Eccl. 3:11b

C. Sacrifices His Son on your behalf. Jn. 3:16

*Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten by God. Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Luke 12:6-7*

## IV. Endures the cross for the lost.

*Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2*
