Matthew 5, 6, 7

Jesus had the crowds, but what he wanted was disciples.

I. DO NOT do “acts of righteousness” to be seen by men!

A. Alms to the poor. (2)

B. Praying (5)

C. Fasting (16)

Three things that determined “piety.”

- We’re supposed to do good deeds.
- Greek language, 50 imperatives.
- Make sure – Right motivations.

II. DO NOT store up treasures on earth. (19)

But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. Mt. 6:20

For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Mt. 6:21

No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money. Mt. 6:24

III. DO NOT worry. (25-34)

v. 31 Food & clothing

v. 34 Tomorrow

Make the Kingdom your priority. (33)
